

Notes to preceding tables on Canada imports of textiles and clothing

On product coverage:

- 1 Textiles and clothing refer to products covered by HS Section XI (HS Chapters 50 through 63) excluding agricultural textile raw materials classified under HS 5001 - 03, 5101 - 03, 5201 - 03 and 5301 - 02.
- 2 Clothing are those covered by HS Chapters 61 and 62.
- 3 Textiles refer to products covered by HS Chapters 50 through 60 plus 63, but excluding agricultural textile raw materials under HS 5001 - 03, 5101 - 03, 5201 - 03 and 5301 - 02.

On exporters:

- 4 NAFTA here refer to 2 FTA partners: Mexico and United States.
- 5 FTA_10 refer to ten FTA partners: Chile, Costa Rica, Israel, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Peru, Switzerland; Colombia, Jordan.
- 6 Pref_48 here refer to 48 preference trading partners: Afghanistan, Angola, Bangladesh, Benin, Bhutan, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cambodia, Cape Verde, Central Africa, Chad, Comoros, D.R. Congo, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Haiti, Kiribati, Laos, Lesotho, Liberia, Madagascar, Malawi, Maldives, Mali, Mauritania, Mozambique, Nepal, Niger, Rwanda, Samoa, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Solomon Islands, Somalia, Sudan, Togo, Tuvalu, Uganda, Tanzania, Vanuatu, Yemen, Zambia. All these 48 are designated as Least Developed Countries (LDCs) by the UN.

On import data:

- 7 Import figures included re-imports.
- 8 Canada appeared as a ranked exporter also for its re-imports.
