

ITCB Private Sector Consultative Committee

1. The Private Sector Consultative Committee (hereinafter referred to as the PSCC) may consult, discuss and tender advice to the Council in accordance with the aims, objectives and functions of the ITCB. It may undertake such consultation or discussion and tender such advice on its own initiative or as may be requested by the Council.
2. Each ITCB Member may appoint one private sector representative of its relevant associations or federations to serve on the PSCC.
3. The ITCB Secretariat shall provide administrative support to the meetings of the PSCC.
4. The PSCC shall have a Chairman elected from amongst its members who may be re-elected at the discretion of the PSCC.
5. The PSCC shall hold at least one meeting in each calendar year, preferably prior to a session of the ITCB Council of Representatives. It may establish its own rules of procedure having regard to the Rules of Procedure of the ITCB Council of Representatives.
6. The PSCC members shall participate in its meetings at their own expense.
