

Notes to tables: United States imports of textiles and clothing

On product coverage:

- 1 Textile and clothing are those MFA products as classified by the US in its 200, 300, 400, 600 and 800 series of category system.
- 2 Clothing are those MFA apparel as classified by the US in its 200, 300, 400, 600 and 800 series of category system.

On country coverage:

- 3 NAFTA refers to Canada and Mexico.
- 4 CAFTA refer to 6 Central American exporters: Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua, Dominican Rep.
- 5 CBI Less CAFTA refer to 19 Caribbean basin exporters: Anguilla, Antigua, Aruba, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, British Virgin Islands, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Haiti, Jamaica, Montserrat, Netherlands Antilles, Panama, St. Kitts-Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent/Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago.
- 6 ANDEAN refer to 4 Andean exporters: Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru.
- 7 SUB-SAHARA refer to 51 exporters: Angola, Benin, Botswana, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Cape Verde, Central Africa, Chad, Comoros, Congo, Ivory Coast, Dibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Kenya, Lesotho, Liberia, Madagascar, Malawi, Mali, Mauritania, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia, Niger, Nigeria, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Seychelles, Sierra Leone, Somalia, South Africa, Swaziland, Tanzania, Togo, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Antarctica, British Indian Ocean island, Mayotte, Reunion, Saint Helena
